## Fireplaces

Dimplex, the company who manufactured the fireplaces in the units has advised that there have been isolated incidences where their fastening screws in the fireplace were not properly tightened, and can lead to arcing under load and overheating, potentially creating a fire hazard. You are able to unplug the unit and check the fasteners to ensure your unit was installed correctly. On the rear of the unit, there is a model number and serial number, and you can contact Dimplex (519-650-3630) if there are problems with your unit. One of the owners contacted Dimplex as their unit had malfunctioned, and they sent out a local repair company to come and fix the unit.
