Dryer Vent Booster Fans

With the weather getting colder it is more important than ever to use the dryer vent booster fans attached to your clothes dryer. Keep the fan on during the entire laundry cycle. Start the fan with your first washer load and when finished with the last dryer load leave the fan on at least 30 minutes with the dryer door open to cool the exhaust pipe. This will help prevent accumulation of moisture on the pipe.

Removing the lint from the screen once a week in the booster fan box will help move air down the exhaust pipe as well as speed up drying time saving you money!

Ventilation of your home in colder weather

There is a fan timer in your home that controls the fan in your main bathroom. It is recommended that this fan is programmed to operate for four hours twice a day, everyday, to control humidity in your home. If you have any moisture buildup in your bathrooms or on windows this will help control it.
