Dryer Duct Cleaning

Clothes tumbling round and round in a dryer may seem harmless, but as the clothes tumble these items are continuously contributing to a stockpile of lint and dust in the dryer's ductwork. The purpose of dryer duct cleaning is to remove that stockpile of lint and dust. This will help reduce the time you have to wait for clothes to dry and decrease the risk of fire.

All residents should have received a notice under their doors about Dryer Duct Cleaning taking place from April 20th to April 24th. The cleaning will begin at 9:00am each day and may take up to an hour per unit. The cleaners will be starting at the top of the building and work their way down to each unit over the week. Please remember you either have to be home when this cleaning takes place or leave a key with a neighbour.
