## Celebration of Light Fireworks

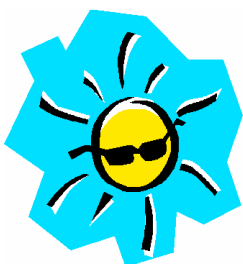
