Fire Alarm Testing This Week

All residents are reminded that the Fire Alarm System will be tested during the days of August 5th to August 7th. Residents **need to be home on Tuesday, August 5th from 8am to 4pm** to facilitate the testing of the fire safety equipment in their units. Any units where alternative arrangements have not been made, or a key is not available, will be entered using a master building key OR a locksmith will be used (and the costs of the lock smith will be billed to your unit).

On August 6th and August 7th the fire safety equipment in the common areas and hallways will be tested. During this time you may hear announcements and/or fire bells. While they are likely tests, be sure to pay attention to any announcements made.
